We are blessed with an already beautiful church filled with many wonderful icons. As with our souls, the beautification and building up of the church is an ongoing endeavor. It is exciting and encouraging to have a new Deisis icon (Christ enthroned with the Theotokos and the Forerunner) in the narthex, welcoming us into the Kingdom, and there is plenty of space where additional icons can be added.

The church is taking requests and donations for icons of individual saints, like the many that already adorn our church. Request forms can be found in the narthex and the parish hall and can be given to Dn. Marc or Sh. Donna Wentzel. The pastor will consider the requests and make final decisions on which icons are approved. The icons are approximately 5' x 2' and cost \$1100. You will also have the option to make additional donations toward future iconography in the church.

While individual saints are being added to our walls, we will also be raising funds for some larger icon projects. General iconography donations, not for individual saints, can be made to the church with "Icons" in the memo. Our goal is to raise an additional \$20,000 for this plan.

Please consider supporting the continued beautification of our church to edify and aid in our worship of God, for ourselves and the future generations.
