"I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic church." The word church used in the creed and in the Bible is *ekklesia*, meaning a

gathering or assembly. Christ promised that whenever we assemble together to remember Him at the eucharist He would be present in our midst (Matthew 18:20). From this we can draw several ideas.

- 1.) In order to be considered a part of the assembly, a person must actually assemble with the others, as the body of Christ.
- 2.) When we assemble together for the purpose of worshipping God, we encounter Him there in the Eucharist and receive healing and restoration in Him.
- 3.) If we plan to assemble to encounter Christ in the Eucharist, the previous six days should be lived in anticipation and preparation of this sacrament.
